**What it is:**

THE VAGINA MONOLOGUES is a celebration of female sexuality in all its complexity and mystery. Based on interviews with over 200 women about their memories and experiences of sexuality, The Vagina Monologues gives voice to women's deepest fantasies and fears, guaranteeing that no one who reads it will ever look at a woman's body, or think of sex, in quite the same way again.

The Vagina Monologues has been performed in cities all across America and at hundreds of college campuses, including UC Berkeley since 2001. It has also inspired V-Day, a dynamic grassroots movement to stop violence against women.

V-Day at UC Berkeley is one of the largest university productions of THE VAGINA MONOLOGUES, raising more than \$24,000 in 2009 for non-profit agencies.

Nearly 100 percent of the V-Day at UC Berkeley's proceeds will go to local and international non-profit agencies that aim to stop violence against women across the world. This year our beneficiaries include A Safe Place, Women's Daytime Drop-In Center, The Pacific Center, and The Gender Equity Resource Center.

This year's event includes:

1. A silent auction, featuring donated goodies from Bay Area stores including sex shop Good Vibrations.

2. Donation drive for two of our beneficiaries, A Safe Place in Oakland and Women's Daytime Drop-In Center in Berkeley, for audience members to drop off needed supplies, such as unopened baby formula, unopened packages of underwear and deodorant.
